Eligibility	•Applicants must be physically healthy and academically prepared.
	•Parents must understand and agree with CIS educational approach.
	•Applicants of any nationality or religion will be considered for acceptance.

Remark	•Students planning to enter grade 10 mid-year should have an appropriate report card from grade 9 and a transcript of any credit courses completed in grade 10.
	•Students wishing to enter grade 11 are required to have a verifiable grade 10 transcript for assessing transfer credits.
	•CIS cannot typically accept students entering the school in grade 12. Parents need to contact the school in advance before making an application.
